



## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Master in Rehabilitation Science (Speech Pathology) is a two-year health science program designed to equip the graduate with a more integrated and analytical perspective than that provided at the undergraduate level as it expands his/her area of professional knowledge. The MRS-SP focuses on the analysis of the anatomic physiological and psychosocial basis for each procedure, thus equipping the graduate with the skills needed to interpret variations in performance, revise procedures, and/or create new ones based on sound principles as necessary.

#### PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- To upgrade standards of professional practice in the Rehabilitation Sciences in the Philippines in the areas of research, teaching, organization and management and clinical practice.
- To develop rehabilitation professionals who are more responsive to the health needs of the country.

- ☐ Satisfactory completion and submission of the required hard bound copies of thesis, and electronic copy of manuscript.
- ☐ Certificate of submission of paper for Publication.
