

MASTER OF MANAGEMENT (PUBLIC MANAGEMENT)



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Master of Management (MM) currently being offered in UP has three areas of competencies: Public Administration, Business Management and Educational Management. All students enrolled in any track will take 9 units of core courses, 18 units of the required courses and 9 units of electives/cognates, with a total credit units of 36 before taking the comprehensive examination.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

Management graduates are needed in the public and private sectors as well as in non-government organizations and people's organizations to craft and supervise activities to advance programs at the macro and micro levels. Graduates of bachelor's degrees who are already employed find a need to develop management skills to make them better equipped for their jobs. Hence, to help in meeting these needs, UP Manila is adapting a system wide graduate program in management.

The following are the grade requirements for each student to be of good standing in the program:

- 1) General weighted average of 2.00 or better;
- Weighted average of 2.00 or better for the major/required courses; and
- 3) No grade of 5.00 in any academic course.
- **A maximum of 5 years is given to a student to finish the program.

Living accommodations for students may be provided in privately-owned housing units/dorms/apartment hotels. Dorms offer lodging and/or board. There are privately-owned eateries around the school.
